ELDRIDGE PARK HOURS

MONDAY AND TUESDAY – CLOSED

**{We will be open Mondays on Memorial day, Labor day, Fourth of July
from 12:00PM – 8:00PM}**

ELDRIDGE PARK RENTALS

A deposit is required within 5 business days of receiving the contract. Remaining balance must be paid in full 30 days prior to your event. If we do not receive this payment, your event will be cancelled and your deposit will be forfeited. Please make checks out to E.P.C.P.S., P.O. Box 3056, Elmira, N.Y. 14905

CAROUSEL -

Family/Non profit	\$125/per hour
Corporation	\$200/per hour

This rental fee is for free rides on the carousel per hour **with the public**. We do offer a "Family Ride" which is a minimal charge of \$50 for up to 50 people, with \$1 per person extra after the initial \$50. This can take place during regular operating hours for **one ride just for your party**. A fee of \$400/per hour will be charged if your event occurs during our peak time in the season.

DANCE HALL -

Family/Non profit	\$75/per hour
Corporation	\$100/per hour

Use of the Whip building is a separate rental fee. Parties can rent the Dance Hall during regular carousel hours. **Parties are responsible for their own tables and chairs.** Parties are responsible for set up and clean up during the hours reserved for your event. Use of the barbeque pit is included with your reservation.

CORPORATE PAVILION I -

Family/Non profit	\$40/per hour
Corporation	\$80/per hour

Use of the pavilion is a separate rental fee. Parties can rent the Pavilion building during regular carousel hours. **Parties are responsible for their own tables and chairs.** Parties are responsible for set up and clean up during the hours reserved for your event. Use of the barbeque pit is included with your reservation.

BARBEQUE PIT - The barbeque pit has five 3'x4' sections. Use of the barbeque pit is included with your reservation of the dance hall and/or corporate I. Parties need to provide their own charcoal, lighter fluid, utensils, etc.

PRICE LIST OF THE RIDES

CAROUSEL: 1 ticket per person

\$50.00 for a private ride, up to 50 people, each additional person \$1.00.

JASPER: 2 tickets per person

The boat holds 6 adults plus the captain. {Ultimately Capt's discretion}

HATCHLINGS: 5 tickets for 1-2 people

7 tickets for 3 people

9 tickets for 4 people

Each boat seats up to 4 people. Weight limit of 650 lbs. per boat max. This is for a 20 minute ride.

MINIATURE GOLF: 5 tickets for age 10 and up

3 tickets for age under 10

3 tickets for wheelchair bound

No animals on the golf course please. Watch your step! Holes 1-9 and 18 are for wheelchair bound.

MINIATURE TRAIN: 1 ticket per person.

Please keep your hands in the cars. We have 4 passenger cars which hold 2 passengers each.

1 TICKET = \$1.00

GOLF COURSE RULES

- 1. Play at your own risk. In the event of an electrical storm, the miniature golf course must be vacated immediately.**
- 2. Only paying customers or persons accompanying paying players are permitted on the miniature golf course.**
- 3. All players must start on the first hole and progress in order; skipping holes or going back is prohibited.**
- 4. Groups are limited to a maximum of 4 players unless group size is adjusted by site staff.**
- 5. Strokes are limited to 6 per hole.**
- 6. Slower groups must allow faster groups to play through.**
- 7. Use only short putting strokes. Full swings are unnecessary and may be dangerous.**
- 8. Everyone in a group must play their first shot before anyone plays their second shot.**
- 9. Replace out of bound ball where it went out. Take one-stroke penalty.**
- 10. Ball resting against an obstruction may be moved six inches.**
- 11. Ball hit by another ball is replaced where it was hit, - no penalty.**
- 12. Golf ball floats in water hazard. Use ball scooper or ask for assistance. take one- stroke penalty.**
- 13. Climbing or sitting on rock structures, trees, light poles, signs, handrails, waterfalls, and other landscape features is prohibited.**
- 14. Smoking, food and beverages are prohibited on the course.**
- 15. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times.**
- 16. Profanity, abusive language or behavior that adversely affects guest safety and comfort are prohibited.**
- 17. Conduct that may endanger the welfare of any person is prohibited.**
- 18. Help keep the golf course clean of litter.**
- 19. No animals on the golf course.**

MINIATURE TRAIN RULES

- 1. No riders under 2 years old.**
- 2. All children under 9 years old must be accompanied by an adult.**
- 3. NO BABIES IN ARMS!!**
- 4. 250 pound weight limit.**
- 5. No drinks, candy, or food in the cars.**
- 6. Keep hands and arms inside the car at all times. DO NOT REACH OUT!!!**
- 7. Remain seated at all times.**
- 8. Do not lean to the side. Face forward at all times!**
- 9. Child must be seated and buckled.**
- 10. Engineer will terminate the ride at any time to enforce these rules.**

ATTENTION:

This is a fast moving carousel.

We wish all our patrons a safe and magical ride on this revolving piece of art and history.

Please help us accomplish this by following the rules listed below...



For your own safety...



- 1) Absolutely NO changing of animals after the bell is rung!
- 2) NEVER attempt to jump on or off the moving carousel platform.
- 3) NO food, drink, candy or gum on allowed on the carousel.
- 4) Children 6 years old and younger MUST be attended by an adult.
- 5) If you are having difficulty and need help...

Get the attention of the ride operator by waving or calling out.

...Again, NEVER attempt to get on or off an animal or the carousel while the ride is in motion.

- 6) Absolutely NO spectators allowed in the fenced in area.

"WAIT 'TILL IT STOPS"



For the animals' safety...



- 1) Do NOT step on the animals. Please use the step assembly.
- 2) Do NOT jump on or abuse the animals. Sit and enjoy the ride.
- 3) Kindly follow the weight limitation guide located on the poles.
Some animals are not meant for adult riders.
- 4) Please be aware of any sharp or hard objects you may be holding or wearing (keys, jewelry, zippers, buckles) as they may damage the finish on the animals.

Rules for The Paddle Boats

Paddle boats seat up to 4 people with a maximum weight capacity of 650 pounds

1. Passengers must have a ticket.
2. Tickets are valid for one 20 minute ride.
3. No children under age 2. {Please ride Jasper instead }
4. Children 2-7 must be with an adult.
5. Children 8-11 must be with an adult or two 12 year olds.
6. No running on the dock.
7. Passengers must wait for assistance from dock staff before getting on or off the paddle boats.
8. Passengers are required to wear life jackets at all times while on the boat.
9. Passengers must remain seated at all times while on the boat.
10. Please do not switch seats while in the boat.
11. Please stay away from the Jasper boat .
12. Do not go to the shore unless it's an Emergency.
13. Do not go near the Center of the fountain.

ATTENTION PASSENGERS:

- Everyone **MUST** wear a PFD (Insurance regulations)
- Children 6 and under must be accompanied by an adult
- Please **NO** food or drink on the boat
- Passengers must stay seated at **ALL** times
- Passengers must keep hands and feet inside the boat
- Please board and disembark the boat at the
- direction of the captain
- 6 passengers on board (state regulations)
- The Captain reserves the right to refuse passengers for safety reasons
- Please be aware that Jasper II makes **LOUD** growling noises at various times during the ride

*If your event is scheduled when the carousel is open to the general public...the only way to “reserve” any time is to ask for a “Family Ride” for up to 50 (\$50 during regular business hours). Just your family/group will be allowed on the carousel at that time. This is usually up to a fifteen minute time frame. Depending on how fast the photographer can snap some photos...that may be an option. If you wish to ride after the photos, and reserve another slot...it will be an additional \$50.
